## **Voter Identification**

As of January 1, 2025:

- All individuals that present themselves to vote at a Pennsylvania polling place must provide valid identification to cast a ballot. Identification must be provided at every election.
- Individuals without valid identification on election day are permitted to cast provisional ballots, but must provide valid identification within five days of voting for the ballot to count.
- Individuals who are disabled, elderly, under the federal poverty line, or who can
  otherwise provide a reasonable explanation for their inability to attain a valid
  form of identification may apply for a free state issued I.D. from the Pennsylvania
  Department of State.

This act takes effect January 1, 2025.
